A city and a camp in Nazi time: How to get an access to the neighbourhood of Weimar and Buchenwald?

An excursion with international postgraduates in cooperation with the University of Halle

Thursday May 9, 2013

8.00	Departure from Halle by bus
9.30	Arrival at the youth meeting center, Haus 5
10.00	What do we connect with the terms "Nazism", "Buchenwald" and "Weimar"? Self introduction of participants with fotos and drawings related to Buchenwald and Weimar Haus 5, Atelierraum
10.45 - 12.15	Guided tour to the former quarry and the former camp including the main gate, the crematorium, the zoo and a room with a model of the area
12.30 – 13.15	Lunch break
13.30 - 16.00	Time for individual exploration (see the introductory film, the restauration department, the foto exhibition "black on white" of the exhibition of art work from the camp time or in reflection of the camp, studying reports written in English)
16.00	Bringing together the impressions and talk about unanswered questions. Exchange and reflections in the plenary. Then: How to cope with the past: Reactions of survivors, and people in Weimar Six biographies, presented with documents. (e.g., Wladyslaw Kozdon, Poland; Robert Büchler, Slowakia / Israel; Rolf Kralovitz, Germany; Stephane Hessel, France; Otto Koch, mayor of Weimar 1937 – 1945)

19.00	Walk to the Buchenwald Memorial, established in 1958

Friday, May 10, 2013

till 9.00	Breakfast and check out
9.15 - 10.00	Direct neighbours: A school and a camp: a walk from the memorial to the Ettersburg castle
10.00	Tour to Weimar (bus stop at "Weimar Atrium": unfinished Nazi center ("Gauiforum"), today administration and shopping mall)
10.30	Walk into the city center with focus on hints (not only) to the Nazi era till Goethe Haus
13.00	Lunch in Weimar
15.00	Goethe Haus (optional), leisure time for individual interests
18.00	Return by bus from Weimar to Halle
